This new Trading Partner Business Center (TPBC) site now supports all of Highmark's medical payer organizations in a single location. As part of this EDI consolidation, all of our payers now offer access to the full range of Highmark-supported HIPAA transactions for Claims (837, 275CA), Inquiry (270/271, 276/277), Prior Authorization (278, 275SR), and Blue Exchange electronic remittance advice (BX835).

The two newest transactions are the 275CA (Claim Attachment) and the BX835 (Blue Exchange Medicare Crossover 835s).

The 275CA allows the submission of claim-related attachments to support standard 837 claims. 275CA access will now be authorized whenever an 837 is requested on a new EDI trading partner or upon request whenever an EDI trading partner already has 837 capabilities.

The BX835 transaction provides Highmark providers with access to electronic remittance advice from other Blues Plans which are made available through the Blue Cross Blue Shield Association (BCBSA). To receive BX 835s, a Trading Partner must first be registered to receive standard 835 transactions. Next, the provider must be affiliated with the Trading Partner to receive BX 835s through the Trading Partner and, finally, the provider must request BX835s from the BCBSA.
